PHASE 1 - PRELIMINARY EXAMINATION

You will face the preliminary examination first which is an objective test of 100 Marks.

In

which 70% weightage will be to the subjects prescribed in syllabus for Law Paper-I and Law

Paper-II, and 30% weightage shall be given to test proficiency in Hindi and English language.

- Order/Judgment Writing

PAPER II (100 Marks)

You will be asked question based on the following:

- The Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973
- The Indian Evidence Act, 1872
- The Indian Penal Code, 1860
- The Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015
- The Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 (Chapter XVII)
- The Probation of Offenders Act, 1958
- Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005
- Framing of Charge/Judgment Writing.

PAPER III - LANGUAGE PAPER (100 Marks)

Paper-A Hindi Essay (50M)
Essay Writing in Hindi Language.

Paper-B English Essay (50M)

Essay Writing in English Language.

NOTE: Minimum marks are 40% in each written paper and aggregate of 50% to qualify for interview. Relaxation of 5% each has been made for SC/ST/PWD.
